Information on placement of, and types of employment obtained by graduates of the school's certificate programs.

Upon successful completion of the program, students may obtain <u>entry-level</u> positions as a heating and air conditioning service apprentice/technician or installer, refrigeration service apprentice/technician, mechanical/machine troubleshooting and repair technician, building/facilities/property maintenance technician, general maintenance technician, industrial maintenance technician, sheet metal worker, preventative maintenance technician, and appliance repair technician. Other entry-level occupations include HVAC/R or maintenance classroom assistant, HVAC/R or maintenance sales of equipment, parts, and supplies, and HVAC/maintenance and repair helper. In addition, some graduates choose to utilize their training to become self-employed in specific areas of the field upon graduation.
