Physical Facilities

Northwestern Technological Institute is located at 24800 Northwestern Highway, Southfield, Michigan, and occupies approximately 35,000 square feet. The first floor includes administrative offices, a library/Resource Center as well as a spacious student lounge area with a food market. The second and third floors contain nine classrooms/labs.

Reasonable Facility Accommodations

To ensure easy access for students, staff, and guests with disabilities, the Institute is equipped with entrance ramps, elevators, and specially equipped restrooms.

Equipment/Tools

To facilitate the hands-on training provided, the Institute has nine classrooms and labs which contain a variety of equipment found in the field such as forced air and hydronic heating systems, split and package air conditioning systems, walk-in cooler, reach-in coolers, ice machines, beverage machines, sinks, etc...

The Institute provides all tools and equipment necessary for the program/course while the student is attending. Students are encouraged to begin purchasing basic HVAC tools throughout their program to better prepare for entry into the field.

Library/Resource Center

The school's library is conveniently located on the first floor of the school, and contains various heating, air conditioning, refrigeration, and maintenance-related resources and periodicals to assist students with their educational pursuits. In addition, HVAC/R troubleshooting software, and internet access are available for student use. An orientation and training session is conducted with all new students on the use of the library.
